Terms and conditions

Unexpected weekend contest

The contest game opens on 15 May at 10 am and ends on 30 June 2023 at 23:59. Participation is free, no obligation.

This "Unexpected weekend" contest is open to any person aged 18 or more, except for directors, members and employees of Geneva Tourism & Conventions Foundation, promotional partners, contest organisers, or any other party associated with the development or administration of this contest, including their family members (parents, children, siblings, spouse), and individuals residing in the same household as the persons referred to above. One entry per person is accepted.

ODDS OF WINNING CALCULATION:

Participants get 1 automatic chance at form validation.

The use of pseudonyms or fake email addresses automatically disqualifies a player. Each internet user may only participate once in the "Unexpected weekend" contest. Participation in the contest via game services or automated game robots is strictly forbidden.

By entering the contest, participants authorise the Geneva Tourism & Conventions Foundation to use their e-mail address without disclosure to partners.

DESCRIPTION AND AWARD OF PRIZES:

The Winner will be selected at random. He/she will win a weekend in Geneva (one night) for two people in a 4* hotel including breakfast for 2 people, win an unexpected activity for 2 people, as well as free public transport with the Geneva Transport Card. The won weekend will be organized during the summer season in Geneva.

The draw will take place within a week after the end of the game contest. The winner will be contacted personally by e-mail (at the address entered during registration for the contest). If a winner cannot be reached or does not respond within 5 days, the prize will become null and void. The prizes cannot be exchanged nor converted to cash.

JURISDICTION AND APPLICABLE LAW:

These terms and conditions are governed by Swiss law.

For any dispute, the participants in the game contest and/or its organisers agree that the place of jurisdiction shall be the Geneva courts. Any disagreement about interpretation, conclusion or implementation of the present general terms and conditions, which cannot be settled amicably, shall be brought before the ordinary courts of the Canton of Geneva, subject to a possible appeal to the Swiss Federal Court.
